 Sport on the Olympic Program

On September 8-14, 2014 **Tashkent, Uzbekistan** will be host to the Free-style, Greek-Roman and Female Wrestling World Championships. FILA again will help to coordinate a Wrestling Science Conference with the Uzbek Wrestling Association, the International Network of Wrestling Researchers (INWR), and the Uzbek State Institute of Physical Culture. The theme of this FILA Scientific Conference is: "**The Continued Development of Wrestling in the Olympic Movement**" and is planned to be held September 12-14, 2014.

The purpose of the conference is to attract the scientific community in the field of wrestling to Tashkent and this important sporting event, to share their scientific achievements, discuss and offer solutions to our problems, and for the transfer of knowledge and experience.

Registration of participants for the Conference can be carried out on the official site of the www.uz-djti.uz until August 20, 2014 where it is also possible to receive detailed information on this action. The registration contribution of the participant is \$ 75 US dollars.

Conference of the International federation of wrestling will take place at the Uzbek State Institute of Physical Culture during holding the World Championship.

Purpose: involvement of scientific and sports community to the solution of topical issues of development of wrestling in the Olympic Movement.

Dates: 12 - September 14, 2014

Conference Venue: Assembly Hall of the Uzbek State Institute of Physical Culture (Tashkent, Akkurganskaya Street, house 2)

During work of conference also following questions will be considered:

1. Historical, cultural and social aspects of wrestling in the Olympic Movement.
2. Traditional and innovative technologies in system of training of highly skilled athletes.
3. Medico-biological problems of development of wrestling.

The program of Conference includes plenary sessions, work on sections (according to Conference subjects) and a poster session.

Poster Session Submissions are being accepted

About 100 Uzbek and international representatives will take part in the Conference: scientific community, members of national sports federations, representatives of higher educational institutions, etc. Besides the scientific program, in the second half of day participants will be able to visit the competition at the Wrestling World Championships. For non-residents, lodging is available at the rate of \$ US dollars 50 with two single meals is provided.

Following the results of Conference the collection of materials will be published.

POSTER SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Posters will be accepted in English, Russian or French languages.

1. The volume of provided theses no more than 3 pages.
2. Parameters of registration of the text or page:
 - The paper size — A4 (210mm x 297 mm)
 - The top field and the bottom field — 20 mm
 - The left field — 30 mm; the right field — 15 mm
 - Font — Times New Roman or Courier
 - Line spacing — single
 - The main font size — 12 pt.
 - Alignment — on width
3. Rules of registration of Thesis
 - Report name
 - Surnames of authors and rank
 - The name of establishment or higher education institution which authors represent
 - City and country
 - Full contact information, at least, one author
4. Contents of Thesis:
 - Introduction (relevance) and problem definition
 - Research objective
 - Research methods
 - Results of research and discussion (scientific contribution, novelty and practical application)
5. Selection
 - Posters will be selected on the basis of criteria of originality, contribution/importance, coherence with a subject, relevance, etc.
 - Posters are printed at the expense of means of organizers of conference. The maximum size of each poster makes: 841 mm (in width) x 1189 mm (in length) (A0 size). Posters have to be rather well visible from distance of 2 meters therefore the original has to be provided in high quality.
